Notes Historically the specialty Maxillofacial Surgeon was gained after graduating from Faculty of Dentistry. Consequently, the educational program included all

basic medical specialties: ophthalmology, pediatrics, hynecology,

hinolaryngology, neurology, general surgery, therapeutics, psychiatry, radiology, oncology, dermatology etc., but it was a little shorter than the program for the

Faculty of General Medicine.

Notes 1 Alternative Study Path: Alternatively candidates can take a diploma in Dentistry

(5 years) and a Certificate in Maxillofacial Surgery (2 years)

OMFS Training Notes

Notes 1 For two years, the resident of maxillofacial surgery attends lectures and

seminars, participates in the work of the surgical department, participates in the discussion of clinical cases, participates as a junior assistant in operations and dressings. At the end of the training, the resident passes the qualification exams and thus passes the initial accreditation as a maxillofacial surgeon. Successfully completed primary accreditation is admission to work in the specialty.

Notes 2 As the reforms are held in our country and directions are often changed, it is difficult to put them into practice. Russian maxillofacial surgeons fulfill the whole work in clinics of the University and regional hospitals, develop and use in practice new surgical technologies.
